2022-2023 Travel Soccer Information: U9 Thru U10

Tryout Dates: June 7th & 8th 2022 – Girls & Boys

Current Dynamo Academy players & new players, you will need to register for tryouts on our website.

Dynamo FC callouts will be conducted at Tabernacle Presbyterian Church 418 E. 34th St. Indianapolis, IN 46205.

After tryouts age groups will have a virtual meeting with their coach.

1.1 Age Groups are defined as follows:

- U9 and Younger: Children born in 2014
- U10 and Younger: Children born in 2013

1.2 Acceptance: You must register at dynamofc.org prior to the callout date. To accept a spot on a team, you must use the Acceptance Link in GOTSPORT and pay a deposit of \$100 to reserve your spot. **All offers given on June 7th and 8th must be accepted within 24 hours, with a deposit paid upon acceptance.**

You will be sent a 'Callout Acceptance' email, which you need to 'Accept'. This is the final step in accepting/securing your child's spot on the team. If you know that your child has been offered a spot but you have *not* received the Callout Acceptance email:

- Check your spam/junk mail folder for the email
- Check your account to make sure you signed up for callouts via the website
- Contact the Club Administrator, kpempek@comcast.net to validate if players have been assigned to teams via the website

1.3 Player Information: After accepting a spot on your child's team:

1. Medical release form will be required in your GotSport account
2. \$100 Deposit will be required to pay online upon acceptance
3. Copy of your child's birth certificate to be uploaded in GotSport
4. Head shot photo of your player in jpeg format for your child's player card will be required to upload upon acceptance in Gotsport

2. Calendar: The 2022-2023 Season for U9-U10 Teams will start August 1st 2022 and end the 2nd week in June 2023

3. Team Expectations: Commitment is for a full year, Fall and Spring Seasons.

Players are expected to attend team training sessions, matches & scheduled functions. Details will be provided in the player handbook.

3.1 Club Expectations: Dynamo works to provide an ideal soccer environment. To do so, Dynamo expects each family to volunteer time to the club, assist with fundraising and help out where needed. A minimum hour volunteer requirement must be agreed to by each family, which is detailed on our website.

4. FEES

4.1 Annual Fees:

- U9 - U10 \$1350 total (\$100 due @ acceptance, Monthly payments of \$156.25 starting 8/1/2022 and ending 3/1/2023)
- Families will be required to keep a credit/debit card or eCheck on file for monthly payments
- All families will be notified of upcoming fee due dates through their Account on the Dynamo website
- Payments are accepted via eCheck or Credit Card
- Fee specific questions can be directed to the Club Administrator
- Scholarship information is outlined below

4.2 What do the Annual Fees include?

- Training sessions: 2 weekly training sessions during season
- Coaching staff including state and nationally licensed coaches and technical directors.
- Winter indoor training sessions: 6 weeks of indoor training at least one day a week
- League Games (Central North Conference)
- Two tournaments per season
- Registration fees for league and referee fees
- Upkeep for Dynamo's fields
- Administration of the club

*Additional Expenses:

- Team Fees- Coaches hotel room for away tournaments, per diem, and mileage for games/tournaments greater than 65 miles away
- Individual teams may play in additional tournaments for an additional fee

4.3 Injury and Release Policy: Full refunds (less the deposit) will be granted only before the 1st practice of the season and only on the approval of the club president. Refunds (less deposit) due to season ending injury will be prorated based on the number of games played to numbers of games in the players league schedule (excluding tournaments), must submit a request to the club administrator for refund within 45 days of the injury. Players leaving the club voluntarily will forfeit all fees paid. Any refund request must be made in writing to the club administrator and approved by the club president. Members will be charged a \$20 administration fee for checks that are returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF). This excludes Covid 19 situations which are detailed in section 5.

4.4 Dynamo FC Scholarship:

- Dynamo FC has scholarship opportunities available each calendar year
- Families interested in applying for a scholarship must complete the Scholarship Application Form (available on www.dynamofc.org) and submit it to the Club Administrator prior to July 1
- All families must pay the non-refundable deposit in order to be considered for a scholarship
- Questions and completed forms should be directed to the Club Administrator

4.5 Uniforms:

The Dynamo Kit is expected to cost approximately \$175

- **Uniform deadline for all new orders is Friday, June 24th**

5. Covid 19

- If the season is unable to begin due to Covid-19 we will refund 100% of the fees paid
- If the season is able to start and unable to be completed Dynamo FC will offer refunds to families on a prorated basis
- All parents must sign a COVID-19 release form prior to participating
